I can't believe it's already been over a month since I started as a ministry trainee! Here's a quick update of what I've been up to over the past few weeks and a few prayer points too.

As we've been looking at the book of Ephesians together on Sunday, I've reminded of what a blessing it is to be a part of God's family, on a large scale and a small(ish) scale at Fulwood. Despite having been a part of Fulwood Church for 3 years, I've been surprised by how few people I know and so I'm super thankful that I've been able to get to know some more of our church family each week despite ongoing restrictions. Please pray that this would continue and that I would be striving to love others in my church well.

One of the greatest encouragements over the last few weeks has been joining a year 13 girls small group. Each week we meet together to discuss the sermon from the previous Sunday and to think



about how we can apply it to our lives. I've loved starting to get to know the girls and being able to pray together about the struggles and joys of life.

Our youth group has continued meeting online on Sunday evenings to discuss the book 'Transgender' by Vaughan Roberts. We are planning to start a Our first week at Bible Training Yorkshire –Some of us were able to meet in person but are now all joining in via Zoom instead. This term we're studving

midweek in person youth group on the 15<sup>th</sup> October, although this is dependent on any changes in current guidelines. After many months of Zoom, it'll be great to meet with some of the young people (sadly only 15 each week) to study the book of Romans and play some socially distanced games together.

As we make plans in such uncertain times with the possibility of tighter restrictions coming in, I've been so encouraged reading Psalm 33 and being reminded than God's plans cannot be stopped. He is in full control and is working out his purposes, even when it's hard to see that.
