After quite a slow start to the year I've been amazed by how many opportunities I've already had here. I've been loving getting to do the North West Partnership bible training course and been genuinely amazed at how rich the bible is. I've also had a number of regular commitments at church such as doing weekly kids talks, youth groups, bible studies, and of course plenty of emailing/admin. I wanted to share with you in particular about the young adult's group that has been an unexpectedly busy part of my time the past month. God seems to be growing this small group and quite a few new people in their 20s have moved to Carlisle and joined our Church since we have started meeting again. It has been my privilege to try to get alongside them and to invite them along to our young adult's bible study on zoom and meet up with them. I'm excited to have them join the Church and praying for growth in our young adult's group not just in number but in our knowledge and love of our God. We're going to be starting a new bible study after half-term (still on zoom) in the book of Jonah so I'm looking forward to that ^(C)

I've also had a few extra opportunities like an evangelistic women's evening on zoom. It's quite hard to describe but I've put our digital flyer on the right to try to give you more of an idea of what it was. We did an autumn theme with soup-related fun and cookery demo as well as a short talk I got to do, using the change and uncertainty we're all facing to shine a light on the gospel and the certain hope offered in Christ. There weren't that many people's friends who came, but it was an evening of fun and faithfulness to God, and I'm especially thankful because a University friend who had been very interested in the bible was able to join from Oxford.



This week is a quieter week for half-term which has been much needed... I've been surprised by how tired I found myself getting and I have found quite a lot of the things really quite challenging over the last month. I'm so very thankful that we live for such a gentle and kind Saviour who loves us to find rest and be strengthened in him.
